

Implemented Women political awareness programme (2069), it has imparted political literacy at the different rural communities and to the political parties' members of Nepal.

It has implemented tourist promotion projects with the objectives - to create awareness on environment of the tourist route, promote ecologically friendly trekking tourism, increased inflow of tourists to contribute to improved livelihood of the marginalized communities and groups in the route. To achieve these objectives it has implemented numbers of training to the Jirel people, at Jirel Village, Dolakha, and at Bhatat Gaun, Village, Sundari, Nepal (2071/01/08-09)

Several researches on cultural preservation made such as it has studied the Ramechhap Bhaluwajor Majiee Community with financial support of GoN.

To achieve its objectives Nanu Foundation has implemented projects partnering with Governmental organization and Non-governmental organizations such as Ministries of local government, ministry of home, ministry of tourist etc. It has been implementing many activities with partnership of NGOs such as Friends of Sankhu, Clean Nepal etc. And also has professional and collaborative linkages with professional organizations such as CIWIN, CONCERN, Women Leading for Change in Natural Resource Management (W-LCN), Conservation Development Foundation (CODEFUND), Rural Development Centre etc.

Nanu Foundation has its own Admin and Finance Rules and Regulation. Recently, it has own Strategic Plan that guides organizational performances. The plan includes gender equity and equality and economic development, prosperous community with access to basic needs, empowered communities realized social justice, gender justice realization, community reconciliation and peace, promoting sustainable agriculture as important areas in addressing challenges basically to promote and enhance rural enterprises.

Management levels and their responsibilities:

General Assembly: There are 7 members of general assembly body, which is the top most level of the organization and passes the final policies.

Executive Committee: It composes 7 members of board in the central level and 7 members of district level's local committee. It executes the projects' plans and approves them as well as recommends the policies to General Assembly to pass them. Regarding District Committees, they recommend the district levels' plan and monitor the projects' activities at local levels.

Programme Director (PD): This position is the head of the organization having roles of planning, coordination, organizational representation, and support in implementation, M&E of the activities, and to achieve the da-to-day outputs.

Management levels and their responsibilities

General Assembly:

General Assembly (GA) comprised of 25 members from different professional backgrounds of public health, epidemiology, medical, nursing, sociology, statistics, chartered accountant and other alternative medicines that approve main policy direction of the organization.

Executive Committee (EC)

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Genesis

Nanu Foundation was established in 2011. Most of the rural communities and urban communities from of Nepal are lagging behind due to lack of awareness, lack of proper education, unseen women's exploitation.
